

Electric Pallet Jack

There is a lever that steers the unit and raises the jack by acting as a pump handle when required. The forks can be lowered back down to the ground by relying on the tiny handle situated on the tiller. This handle releases hydraulic fluid when it is activated. The forks are situated on levers and there are front wheels found on the inside end of the forks. The levers are attached to specific linkages that have their own levers uniting with a cylinder. The hydraulic jack raises at the end with this system as the links force the wheels down. The forks vertically raise above the jacks' front wheels to lift the load up past the floor and for safety reasons, loads are only raised to clear the floor. Usually, pallet jacks have steering wheels located at the front of the machine, while each fork is equipped with a single or double wheel design.
